To help our students set higher goals and measure their skills in the world outside the four walls of the school, the school provides them many chances to participate in different national and international level inter-school contests and olympiads. This year our students participated in international Hindi Olympiads organised by Hindi Vikas Sansthan and Hindi Vikas Manch-Delhi, Hindustan Olympiad by 'Amar Ujala', Little Champs Olympiad by ITO, BOB Wonderkid, SIP, Arithmetic Genius Contest, ISO, IMO and IGKO of SOF Olympiads. Advik Malik (IV-F) and Gargi Bhardwaj (III-A) won RASHTRIYA HINDI PRATIBHA SAMMAN and were honoured by Hindi Vikas Sansthan in Teen Murti Bhawan, Delhi. School also grabbed seven gold, twenty silver and twenty two bronze medals along with it. School also won Champion's Trophy in BOB Wonderkid Interschool Competition by winning maximum number of medals in town. Two hundred and fourteen students from K.G. Section participated in Little Champs Olympiad out of which 191 won gold medals, 14 silver and 4 bronze medals. Rest of the results are still awaited when the report is being written.

Nitya Dabral I(IV-C) brought laurels to school in the field of gymnastics and Aditya Verma (II-A) in instrumental and singing at zonal levels.

To inculcate patriotism and love for our multicoloured cultural heritage, S.D.P.S. marks all national and religious festivals and other important cultural events with great enthusiasm. Our morning assemblies mark all these along with the marking of the day on a class-wise basis. Pairing states Arunachal Pradesh and Meghalaya, class-talent and subject oriented presentations added more educative charm to our morning assemblies.

SAKSHAM, the sports extravaganza was a new feather added in the crown of co-curriculars in school this year in which 100% strength of the school took part and enjoyed participating in allotted sports and games class-wise.
